



Paint Parties with Geordanna

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need artistic ability to have a painting party?

No, not at all! I will teach you and your guests step by step. This is all about having fun with friends while empowering yourself to create a beautiful work of art.

2. What is the minimum number of people I need to hold a private party?

I require at least 8 people per party. Max 10. Larger parties can be accommodated occasionally so be sure to ask me!

Each attendee must pay online (through PayPal) or prior to starting the party. I take cash, check, or charge.

3. What is the length of the party?

15 minutes schmoozing

15 minutes intro

1-1.5 hours of instruction time

30 minutes of clean up

2.5 hours TOTAL

I arrive an hour before party time to set up.

Your guests should arrive no later than 10 minutes before the time we agree upon for the instructing to start. It will give them time to get settled.

4. What is the booking/cancellation policy?

Parties must be booked at least a week, preferably two weeks in advance. Full payment must be made prior to party or upon arrival to party in the form of cash, check or credit/debit card. I have to have the specific number of attendees so I can ensure I have the enough supplies. If you cancel 7 days before the date of the party I will give a full refund. If you give at least a 72 hour (3 days) notice of cancellation, I will issue you a "credit" to be used for another party at a later date.

5. How much does it cost to host a party?

Prices are per person with a minimum of 8 people in attendance. \$40 per person for an 11x14 canvas, this is the standard. Unless otherwise noted I will assume you want the 11x14. I do take request for a larger canvas and the cost would be \$48 a person.

6. I want to host a party with a specific theme but do not see a painting in the gallery that matches that theme. Can I request a new painting?

I am happy to create a painting specifically for your event. There is an additional non-refundable \$45 fee for custom paintings but for a limited time the fee is waived. I will need at least two weeks advance notice of your request.

7. Can each person choose their own paintings?

No. I will be instructing step by step on one painting of choice but any artistic addition done by you or your guests is encouraged!

8. Is there a minimum age requirement?

The adult painting parties are BYOB, thus the minimum age requirement is 21.

The kid's painting parties have an age requirement of 8 years old.

9. What kind of paint will we paint with?

Acrylic, which dries very quickly, resulting in a piece of art that is ready for transport at the end of the party.

10. What should I wear?

Wear something that is comfortable and that you can paint in. Though this is not messy, I will provide aprons but remember that sometimes accidents do happen so please wear something that can take a drop or two of paint.

11. Do I need to do anything for the party?

Yes, if you are the host/hostess, you will need to provide tables and chairs for your guests. I suggest a space with ample lighting be used. The adult parties are BYOB so you are encouraged to bring your drink of choice. I will provide all of the art supplies you need to complete a painting (canvases, paints, brushes, palettes, water cups, table top easels) plus table coverings, floor coverings and aprons. I will need access to running water and a sink.

12. How far do you travel?

Throughout Dallas and surrounding suburbs, basically 30 miles from zip code 75205. I will travel further for a small fee depending on how far. I also travel to Houston quite a bit and have held some parties there. Just contact me and we will work it out.

13. Are gift certificates available?

Yes! They make a great gift.

14. Who is the instructor?
